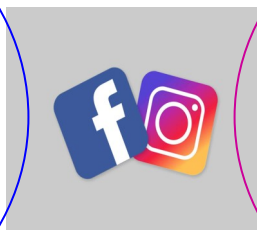

Battle of the Borders 2019

Battle of the Borders SHC Grand National Qualifying show was held this year on February 16 & 17 at the Albury Wodonga Equestrian Centre.

Luckily for us we were not affected by the heat and the weather was very kind to us. We were very blessed with beautiful grounds for our competitors to ride on and spectators to watch the exhibitors.

We anticipated that this year would attract more competitors and we were not wrong. Our show was very well supported with 311 entries.

Competitors came from far and wide to compete and the standard was very high. We really have raised the bar here on the border and raised the profile of SHC in the process.

The show this year was extended to include Home Produced classes which were very popular. The winner was 'Monrose Park Music Man' owned by Holly Dalglish.

Also the Leading Rein classes proved to be very highly competitive with the eventual winner of the Mini Championship going to 'Braeburn Park Spring Dance' and Annabelle Richardson.

This year we also continued with "Laura Berben Memorial" class. This class was developed to honour a young lady who had shown horses successfully in our area but who tragically lost her battle with breast cancer. We decided to honour her with this class and donate all entry fees to the McGrath Foundation. This year we donated \$500 raised from this event. This event was a highlight of the show and was well supported by competitors and sponsors. The winner was Tracie Lee Wells on her horse 'Wangilla Costar'. A very emotional moment as Tracie had been runner up on two previous occasions and was a close friend of Laura Berben.



A dinner was held on the Saturday night with our President Tony Norris speaking and presenting his address on the future of SHC Australia. Many questions were asked and answered. SHC Australia is in safe hands.

We are a small but very hardworking committee with a shared love of the show horse. But all the hard work has paid off with a very successful show for 2019.

Thankyou to all of our committee members, sponsors and helpers on the day.

Next year we look forward to AWEC having a complete new upgrade with the addition of new stables and improved facilities for competitors. This will no doubt attract many more competitors to Battle of the Borders in 2020.

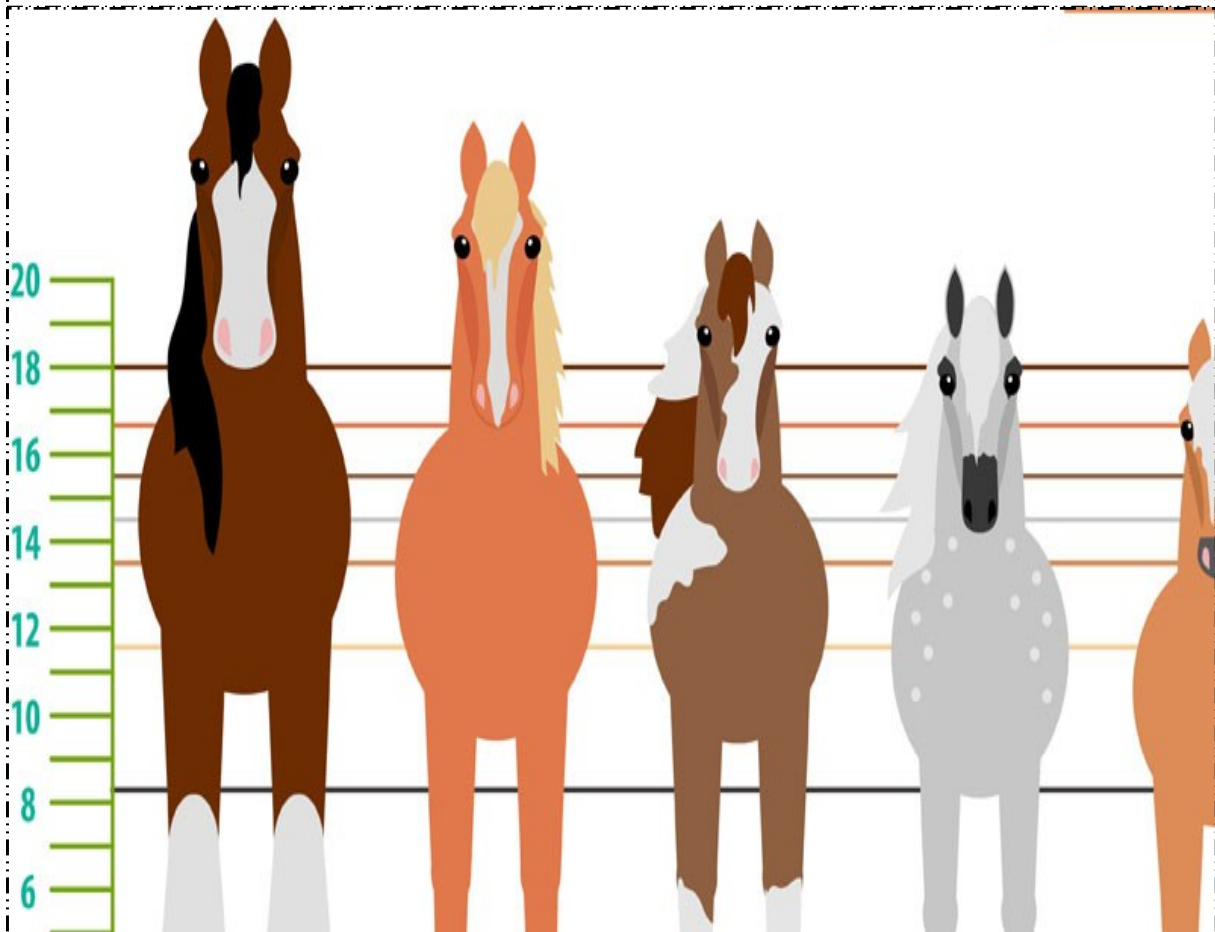

SHCA CERTIFICATES OF HEIGHT

As of **1 July 2019**, the SHCV is required to charge a Measuring Fee as determined by the SHCA for SHCA Certificates of Height. Until now, the SHCV has included measuring fees into its annual membership fee. The current fee for a SHCA Certificate of Height is \$15 per horse. We have received the following advice from the SHCA.

“The SHCA has been working hard to ensure that all rules and regulations are enforced consistently by all Affiliates and Constituent Affiliates. *SHCA Measuring Scheme and Rules, Section 13* requires a Measuring Fee to be paid at the time of measure and this change will ensure that Victoria is consistent with all other Affiliates and Constituent Affiliates. SHCA has discussed the removal of a Measuring Fee, however, most Affiliates rely on the Measuring Fee to ensure that the cost of holding measuring days is covered.”

The SHCV will take this requirement into account when setting its Membership Fees for 2019/2020.



BIG NEWS

Your SHCV Committee do not make changes without careful discussion and consideration. Our Committee is not getting any younger and we feel the need to consolidate our events to try and reduce the workload on not only the Committee but also our Volunteers.

With this in mind we are thrilled to announce that this year will see the SHCV Southern Stars and SHCV Junior Equestrian Showcase run over the weekend of 26 & 27 October 2019 at Tatura Park.

We have done our best to avoid clashing with other like-minded events, however we are sure you understand this is not always possible and we apologise for any event clashes.

This will make for a great weekend of Grand National qualifying events all at one venue. We hope to see you there.

Showing the way

SHCA PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Having already attended the NSW Youth Clinic, NSW Bare Equestrian Pacific Coast Hack Championships and the SHCV Battle of the Borders, I have hit the ground running for 2019. It is always a pleasure to attend as many SHC events as possible as it provides me with a great opportunity to stop and chat to everyone in attendance and listen to feedback, good or bad. Although the SHCA can't achieve everything at once, members of the showing community have provided me with many great ideas and suggestions which I have taken on board.

SHCA Social Media Policy

The SHCA recently introduced an updated and comprehensive Social Media Policy. The SHCA Social Media Policy has been developed to inform the SHCA community about using social media in way that enables people to participate, while being mindful of their responsibilities and obligations. It is important to note that you are in breach of the Policy should you post or share material that brings or risks bringing the SHCA and/or its Affiliates, the sport, officials, members or sponsors into disrepute. In this context, bringing a person or organisation into disrepute is to lower the reputation of that person or organisation in the eyes of the ordinary members of the public. I can't say this strongly enough - If you are a user of social media, you must read this document as a breach of the SHCA Social Media Policy by you may have serious implications.

SHCA Member Protection Policy – Draft

The SHCA is also in the final stages of approving a SHCA Member Protection Policy (MPP). Minor changes have been proposed to the final draft and this should be approved in the coming months. The MMP is designed to set the expectation around behaviour and outlines our commitment to a person's right to be treated with respect and dignity, and to be safe and protected from discrimination, harassment and abuse. I have a zero tolerance approach to inappropriate behaviour and this Policy will provide the SHCA with the extra and much needed support in setting and enforcing behavioural expectation. The reputation of the sport is being impacted by the inappropriate behaviour of a few and this cannot continue. I am passionate about the sport, and our members and volunteers have a right to enjoy the sport without harassment, intimidation and abuse.

Grand Nationals

Preparations for the 2019 Hufglocken Grand National Horse and Rider Championships has been at full flight now for many months. It is a huge event and the effort by everyone involved has been tremendous. With a new organising committee, there have been challenges but I am very excited with what we have organised for our competitors and supporters. Competing at the Grand Nationals is a not a rite of passage and should always be considered a huge honour. Qualifying to compete can only be achieved through hard work, talent, commitment and determination and is the ultimate achievement in our sport. I congratulate everyone who has qualified to attend and I look forward to seeing you there.

With gradual changes being introduced by the SHCA, I continue to be excited about the future of our sport. Yes, there is always more that can be and will be done, but change needs to be carefully thought through and gradually introduced. Whilst I embrace positive change, not everyone is so willing and that needs to be taken into consideration.

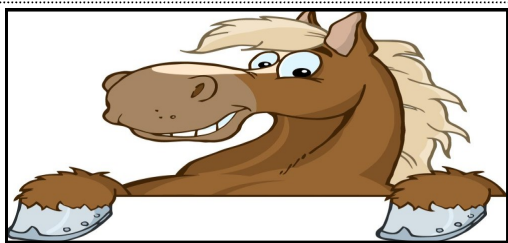
