ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Thank you for your entry to **2020 SHCV Battle of the Borders**. We are gearing up for a big weekend with record entry numbers. **There are some changes to Stabling, Camping and Day Parking** this year so please read the information below carefully. The attached maps will help make sure you know where you are going before you arrive.

STABLING

Stables can be accessed **from 12.00pm Friday until 9.00am Monday**. A stable allocation list will be published on the **SHCV Northern Victoria & Border District Facebook page, SHCA Database** and the **SHCV Website**, however may it be subject to change. Each stable will have 3 bales of shavings included and the will be unwrapped. Extra shavings ordered will also be unwrapped and placed in your stables. A limited number of extra shavings maybe available for purchase, please see the office.

Undercover Yards will be used this year and will have 3 bales of unwrapped shavings included. The venue day yards are not to be used at any time. Any competitor occupying these or any other yards, occupying a stable they have not been allocated or occupying stables prior to 12.00pm Friday will be required to pay a \$150 stabling/yard fee.

No horse is to be placed in an empty stable as ALL stables have been allocated.

PRODUCE SUPPLIES

There is no onsite produce supplies this year. Parkside Produce will be doing deliveries for Feed supplies on Friday and Saturday. Please phone 02 60247766 to place your order 13 Osburn Street, Wodonga 3690 Victoria.

CAMPING

Please look at the camping areas in the maps attached. Use only your allocated camping number and if you are unsure about the correct spot please check with the office. Please note all camping sites have been allocated and your efforts to cohabitate with other competitors are much appreciated.

Only those allocated Generator Camping are allowed to be parked in this area at the back of the permanent stabling.

Please note that the connecting of water systems in your truck/float to a tap is not permissible. Water points are limited and need to be left free for all competitors to use as required.

HOME PRODUCED CLASSES

MEASURING

All measuring cards must be available for viewing to collect your exhibit numbers. All registration papers/height cards must be carried and available if requested by a member of the committee or other authorised person. The measurer for the 2020 SHCV Battle of the Borders is Jo Moore. Please fill out measuring application form before you attend the measuring stand. These can be downloaded of the SHCA website.

Measuring fees are to be **PAID** at the office **PRIOR** to attending measuring. **CASH ONLY EXACT CHANGE PREFERRED**

WORK AREAS

NO HORSES ARE TO BE EXERCISED OR WORKED ON THE GRASS ARENA. The sand work arena is available from 12.00pm Friday for working horses and is the ONLY work area for the duration of the show. Lunging is only permitted on the sand arena. The grassed area will be open from 6am-7.30am Saturday and Sunday for arena familiarisation. No access to this arena is available at any other time.

All horses are to be stabled from 11pm-5am. There will be a maximum fine of \$500 if any horse is worked during these hours

MARSHALLING AREA

All competitors are required to attend the marshalling area **20 min** prior to the timetabled commencement of each class. Upon entering the Marshalling area competitors may not leave and no person(s) is to approach horse or rider without expressed permission of the Ring Master or Ring Steward. Failure to comply with this may lead to the elimination of the competitor (Horse and Rider) from that class. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

CLASS TIMETABLE

The timetable will be published on the SHCV website, SHCV Northern Victoria & Border District Facebook page, SHCA Database and included in the catalogue.

Careful consideration has been made to the timetable to avoid clashes. If you have a potential clash please notify the ring steward PRIOR to the event start time.

We have a large and busy program over the 2 days of the show, it is imperative you are at the ring for judging when your class is marshalled. The Committee will not be held responsible if you miss your class if you are late to marshalling. The timetable maybe subject to change.

PRESENTATIONS AND CLASSES

Classes in Blacklocks Arena for the duration of the show will not be held for Riders or Horses. Rings 2 & 3 will wait for competitors within reason.

All presentations of Grand National Qualifying classes on the SUNDAY will be held in Ring 2. Once the judges have finished scoring in Blacklocks Arena and Arena 3, horses will move to ring 2 and the Presentation area for the awarding of each class. This will allow the next classes to continue. A handler may hold the horse for presentation. Handlers must be suitably attired and have closed shoes (no thongs or sandals).

WORKOUTS

All horses in Grand National qualifying classes will be required to do a workout. There are set workouts for all classes which will be published on the **SHCA Database**, **SHCV Northern Victoria & Border District** Facebook page and included in the catalogue. Please take the time to learn your workouts.

Only the 10 finalist in the Preliminary classes will be required to do a workout.

CATERING

Catering will be available ringside for breakfast from approx. 7.30am both days. Food will be available all day and into the evening. A coffee van will also be available from late Friday through till Sunday afternoon. Catering over the weekend will be provided by the WP&CS North East & Border RPG and Brew it Coffee. Brew it Coffee will be catering from 1pm Friday

Friday Night Cross Country Pizza Ovens will be Catering from 5.30pm. Pizzas are \$15 each.

SHCV NV&BD Sub-committee will be holding a dinner in the club room approx 6.30pm Saturday night. Cold meats, salad, deserts and a drink is included (glass of Wine for adults/soft drink for children) at a cost of \$15/adult and \$10/child. Limited Dinner tickets are still available

CHANGES

If the SHCV NV &BD Sub-committee have to make changes to the measuring times and/or timetable, the changes will be announced at regular intervals during the show and published on the **SHCV Northern Victoria & Border District** Facebook page.

WITHDRAWALS, SCRATCHINGS AND CLASS TRANSFERS

As we use the SHCA database system for our 2020 SHCV Battle of the Borders show it is vital that exhibitors advise the Show Secretary of any scratchings, withdrawals, rider changes or class transfers as soon as possible. By keeping our records up to date with this information we can provide the most current information to SHC members in the form of results.

SWABBING

Horses competing at 2020 SHCV Battle of the Borders will be swabbed. The Swab Steward shall supervise the selection of the horses to be swabbed. Any competing horse may be selected for swabbing. Once a horse has been selected for sampling, the Swab Steward or an appointed Official will inform the rider/handler of the horse that is to be tested. A horse that is to be swabbed **MUST NOT** leave the arena before being escorted to the swabbing box by the Swabbing Steward. Any exhibitor that fails to comply with this instruction will be eliminated.

TREATMENT SHEET

A treatment sheet (available from the Show Secretary & SHC website) is required to be lodged for any horse that has been administered any Treatment, Foreign Substance, Medication, Drug, Prohibited or Banned Substance, within 30 days prior to and/or on day of competition. The Treatment Form shall be accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate containing full details of any ailment and or injury and treatment, and be forwarded to the Secretary within 24 hours of the initial treatment. If the treatment occurs within 24 hours of event commencement, the treatment form must be lodged with the Show Secretary as soon as possible, but no later than 7:00am on the day of competition. Where the horse required continued treatment (after the form has been lodged) a written report detailing the treatment shall be submitted prior to the day of competition concluding.
