PHOTO GARLANDS

The committee are trialling a new concept whereby winners can enhance their winning experience by capturing the moment by using a SHCV photo garland. The garland will not be awarded by the judge in the ring, the winning competitor will move off to the photo wall to have the garland placed on the horse for the purpose of the photo. The committee will purchase three Garlands being Hack, Galloway and Pony. At the completion of the show all winners of each class (Hack, Galloway and Pony) will be placed into a draw to takehome the photo garland. There will also be replica garlands available for purchase by any winner, if they wishto retain the garland captured in the photo. We purchase our garlands from *Lyn Milburn Garlands* (0413 189085) and the cost of the replica's garlands are \$225.00. If you do wish to purchase a garland, you have a timeline of 4 weeks from the completion of the show to order.



MAXIMUM SCORE 100 points

1.A judge shall assign a score, in points, as above for each exhibit Involved in the section they are assigned. The total score for each exhibit shall be derived by adding the scores of each of the judges, with a maximum score of 100 points.

- 2. Should the final score result in the awarding of equal points for two or more exhibits, the result shallbe decided by the points allocated by Judge 1.
- **3.** Should the points allocated to the exhibits by Judge 1 be the same, then the result shall be determined by Judge 2.
- **4.** Should the allocation of points by Judge 2 to the exhibits be the same, then the result will be be be be be the allocation of points of Judge 3.
- **5.** Should all three scores be equal for the said exhibits, then the result shall be determined by all three judges, conferring to determine the outcome.

Junior Equestrian Challenge Judging Categories and Guidelines:

1. Rider

The assigned judge shall assess the position of the rider and consider the rider's ability to maintain acorrect, well-balanced, deep and supple seat, with the rider being in perfect harmony with the horse. The rider should demonstrate the ability to apply the aids of leg, hand and body accurately and effectively upon request.

2. Overall Presentation of Rider and Mount

The judge shall assess the first impression of the horse/rider partnership, the cleanliness and presentation of the horse, the cleanliness and suitability of the bridle and saddle combination to complement the horse, and the presentation of the rider to create a coordinated picture. This is not a Turnout Class.

2. Ridden Mount - Suitability, Manners & Performance

The assigned judge shall assess the suitability of the mount for the child rider; the overall quality and presence of the horse; the manners, paces and education of the horse; acceptance of the bridle; and transitions between gaits. The 'greenness' of a horse shall not impact the outcome. NOTE: For more information refer to the Guide to Showing booklet produced by the SHCA and available from SHCA website.

Turnout classes are a long-standing tradition. The traditional judging criteria has been maintained around presentation, equipment, horse, and rider to determine the best all round horse and rider combination. The Turnout classes presented today are almost identical to those seen a century ago, such as the hand-picked riding jacket and woollen breeches, both intrinsic elements in the tradition of turnout classes. The highest standard in equestrian turnout is the prestigious Garryowen Equestrienne event held at the Royal Melbourne show annually.

Turnouts are judged on a point system with one judge assigned to one or more criteria. The scale of points is:

The combination with the highest score wins. In the event of equality, the points for Riding Ability and Manners and Paces are added together to determine the winner. If there is still equality, Conformation and Soundness should determine the winner. If still undetermined, General Appearance points will be considered, then Saddlery and finally Costume.
